SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., Kappa Phi Lambda Chapter, Howard County, MD, with the financial support of The Alpha Foundation of Howard County, Inc., presents the Chapter Scholarship Program. This program encourages student academic achievement through financial support for post-high school education. Since 1975, the Chapter has awarded over \$350,000 in scholarships.

The following scholarships will be offered during the HCPSS School Year, 2022-2023

■ DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Several scholarships, ranging in value from \$1500 to \$4000 will be awarded to high school seniors.

- One \$4000 Marian & Brother Cecil G. Christian Memorial Scholarship
- One \$2000 Brother Freeman Louis Sands, Sr. Memorial Scholarship
- Three \$1500 Outstanding Scholar Awards

■ MLK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY (HIGH SCHOOL)

- Any African-American high school graduating senior with Howard County, Maryland residency is eligible.
- Applicants should have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and have demonstrated leadership and community service.
- Recipients must attend a two or four year accredited college or university during the 2023-2024 school year.

■ SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

To be considered for an MLK scholarship award, candidates must submit a package that includes the following:

- A completed Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., Kappa Phi Lambda Chapter Scholarship Application Form
- An official high school transcript
- A 1-2 page essay addressing the essay prompt
- Two letters of recommendation. At least one of the letters must be from a faculty member at your high school. Recommendations from family members are not permitted.
- Copy of your official Student Aid Report based upon a completed FAFSA form (optional). Students with a demonstrated financial need may receive additional consideration.

■ SELECTION AND AWARDS

The Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., Kappa Phi Lambda Chapter, selects winners based upon the criteria for each scholarship award through the Education Scholarship Subcommittee. Any student may receive a maximum of one scholarship award approximately sixty days (60) after the application submission deadline. Award values may be subject to change.
